message for you."**

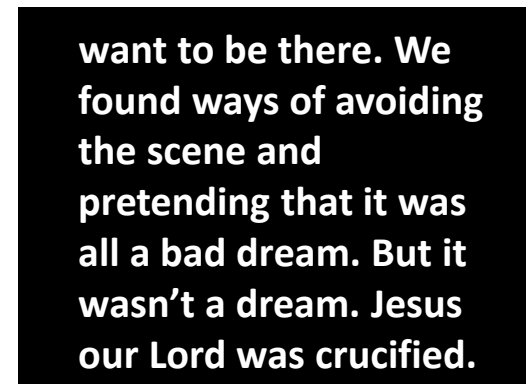
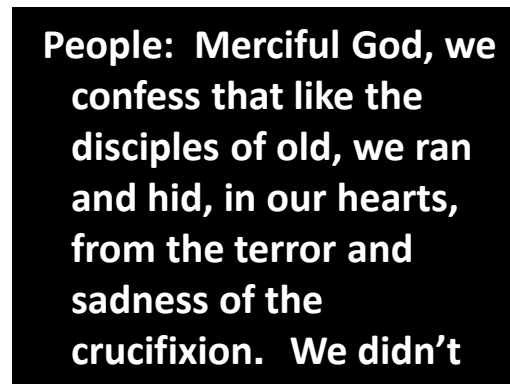
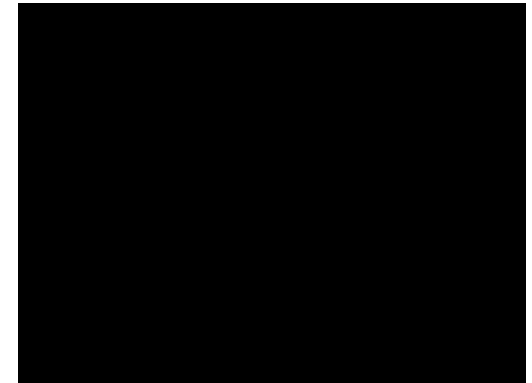
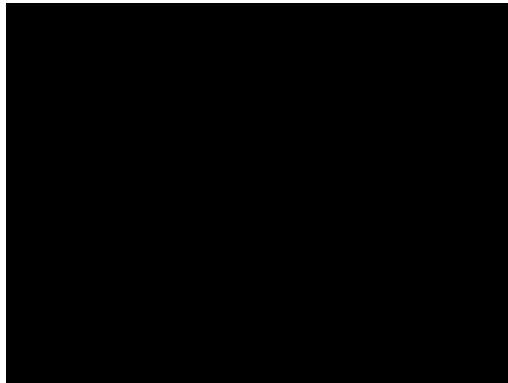
**So they left the tomb

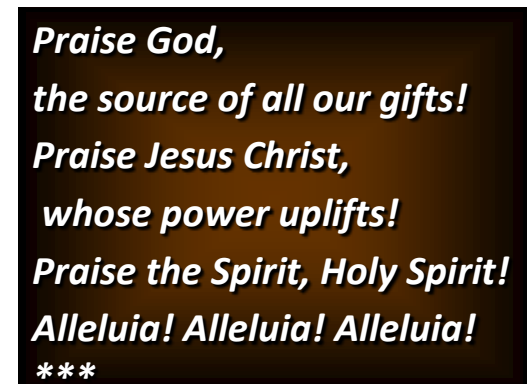
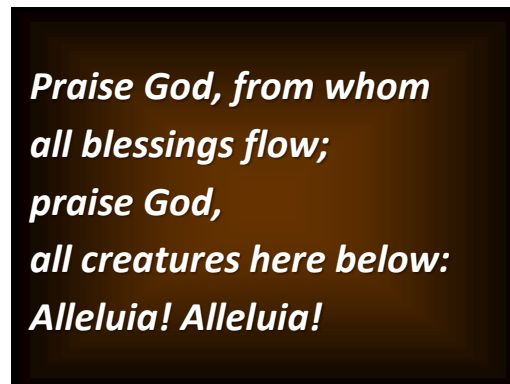
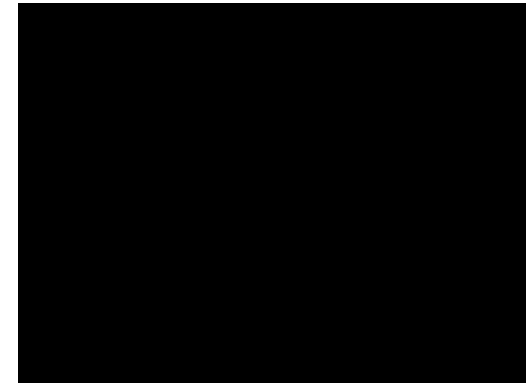
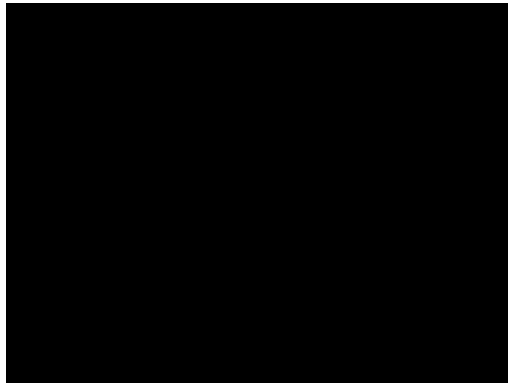


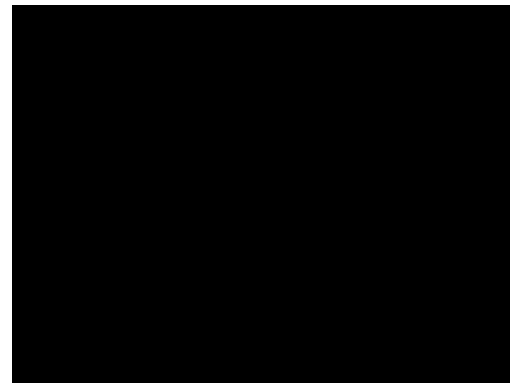
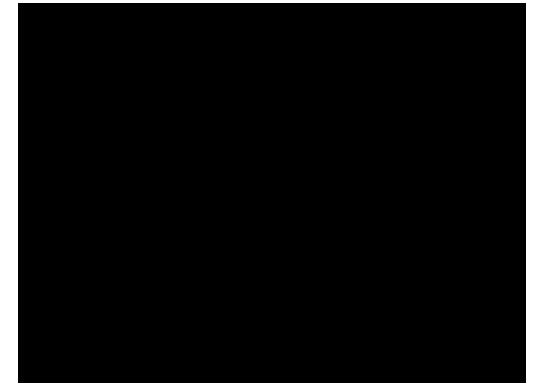
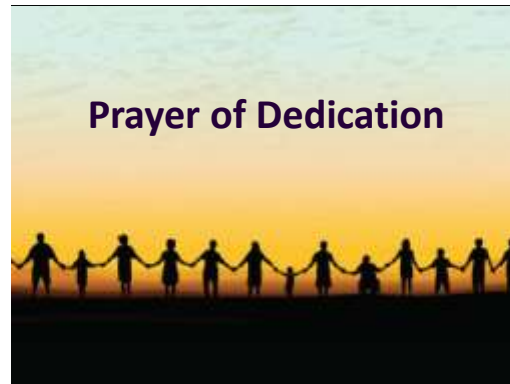
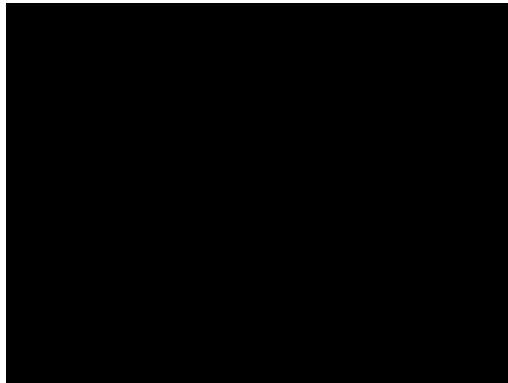
The Lord's Prayer

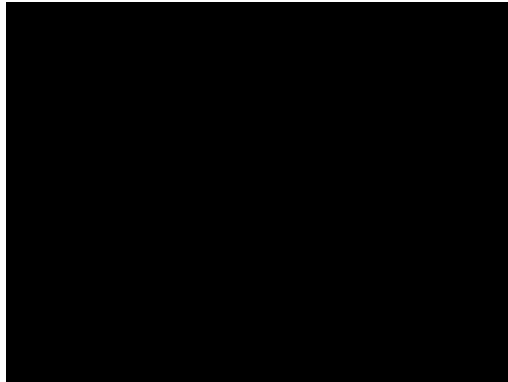
