go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."














People: Merciful God, we confess that like the disciples of old, we ran and hid, in our hearts, from the terror and sadness of the crucifixion. We didn't




















Thine Be The Glory

as we forgive those


who trespass against us.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.










Praise God, from whom all blessings flow; praise God, all creatures here below: Alleluia!
