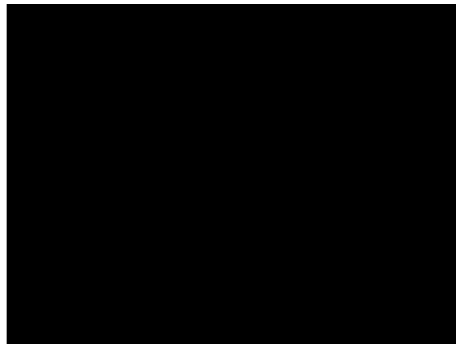
**in sad children, feet without shoes, eyes without hope; in war hymns that glorify death; in deserts where once there was life.**
