Then Paul stood in front of the Areopagus and said, "Athenians, I see how extremely religious you are in every way. For as I went through the city and looked carefully at

**Since we are God's offspring, we ought not to think that the deity is like gold, or silver, or stone, an image formed by the art**



**day on which he will have the world judged in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed, and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead." \*\*\***


