And whatever you do,

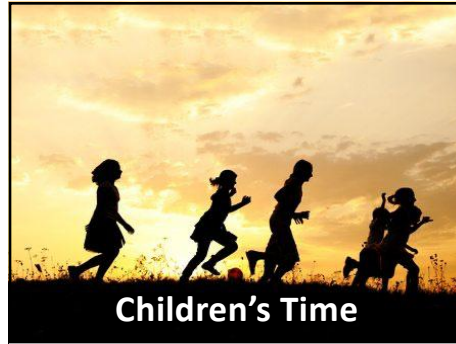
