we are truly living as you would have us live. Teach us again about your forgiving and healing love. Show us ways of merciful living that we may extend

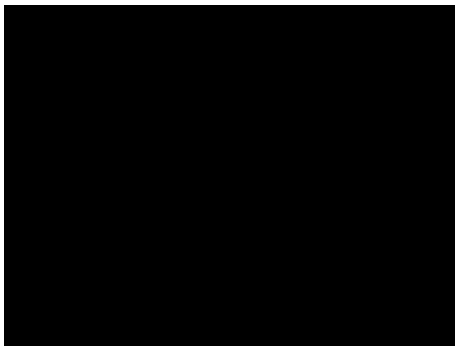
