sinner." Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, "Look, half of my possessions, Lord, I will give to the poor; and if I have defrauded anyone of

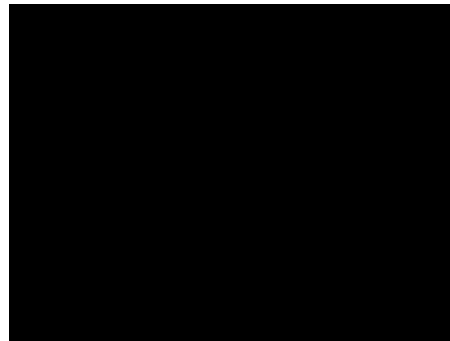

Son of Man came to seek out, and to save the lost.”

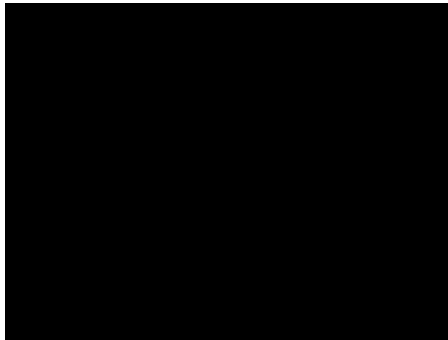

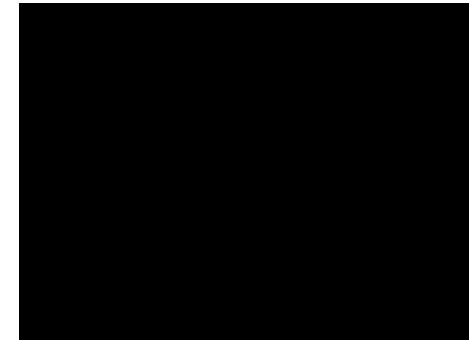

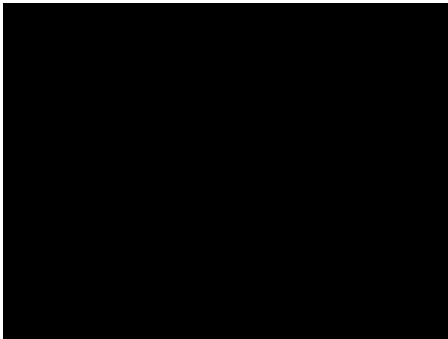
teach us to make gratitude and sharing our way of life; through the grace of Jesus Christ.
