**nothing in all creation is able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus. This is the faith in which we stand.**

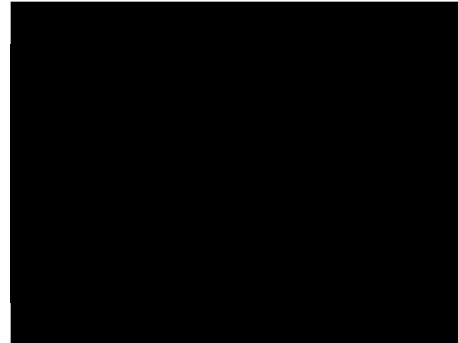

**Leader: We rejoice in this assurance:**

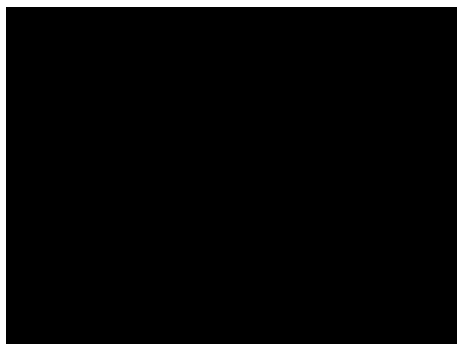
**People: If we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord.**
