outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed day by day. For this slight momentary affliction is preparing us for an eternal weight of

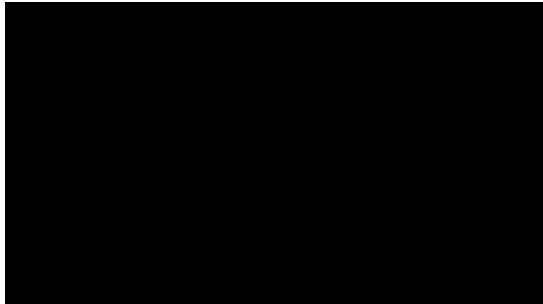

cannot be seen is eternal.

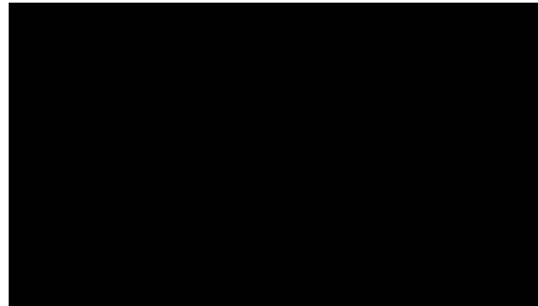

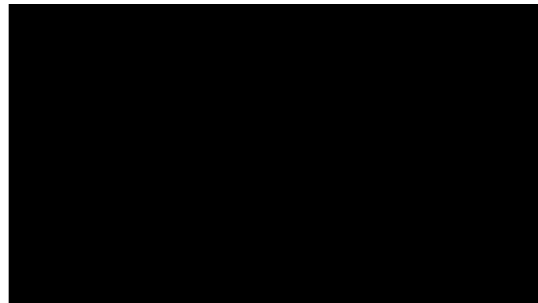

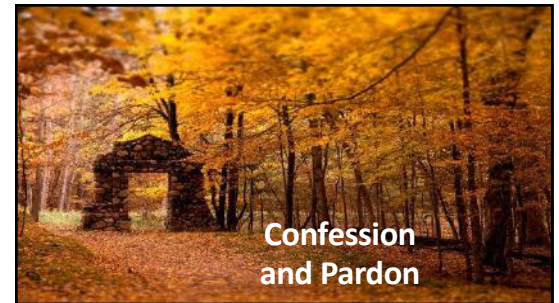

People: we have stifled generosity and left little time for others.

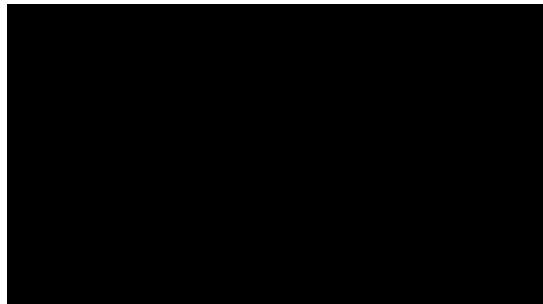
