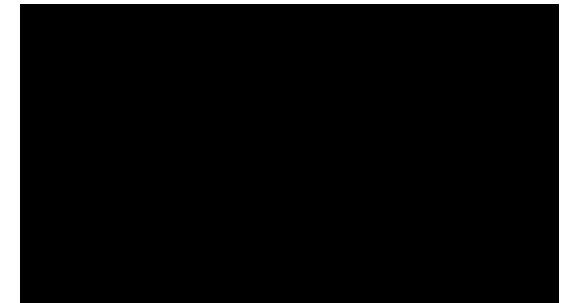
glory to your people Israel."
