Jesus v. Suffering

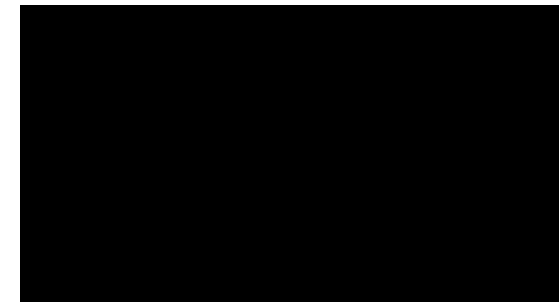
Jesus should be our example in suffering.
