in part, and we prophesy only in part; but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child,



part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.



Challenge us in the ways we have chosen not to love. Move us toward genuine patience, kindness and humility. Let us be moved to love especially when it is inconvenient


